The 5th IWA International Young Water Professionals conference (YWPC 2010) held at the University of New South Wales, Sydney, 5-8th July, will provide an international forum for young researchers and professionals working in the water sector to present their work and meet their peers from all over the world. Based on the 218 abstracts submitted in Dec 2009, it is anticipated that 200 delegates from 37 countries will be attending YWPC 2010.

The continuing professional development of Young Water Professionals (YWPs) is essential to provide a workforce which is adequate in size, capable in skills and strong in leadership to fulfill the present and future needs of water and wastewater industries. It is important that YWPs take home an understanding of the varied and exciting opportunities available to them by pursuing a career in the water sector. YWPC 2010 seeks to engage students and young professionals with an exciting program incorporating technical presentations, career development, technical tours and social events.

Conference topics are broad and include the water cycle, water and wastewater technology, engineering, science and management with a water focus. 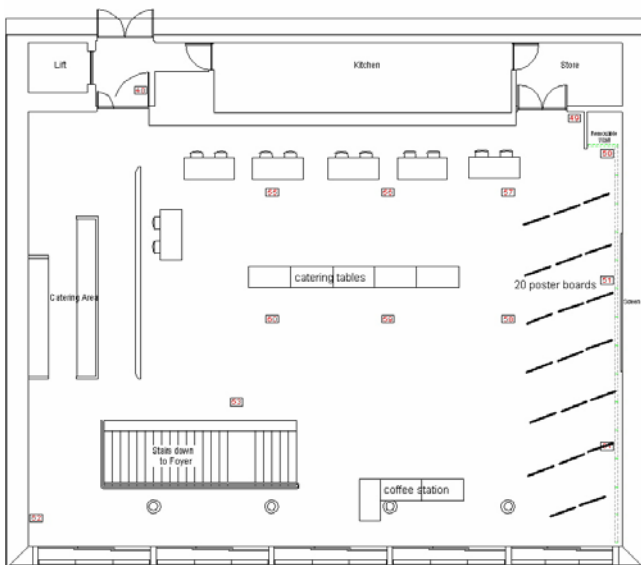

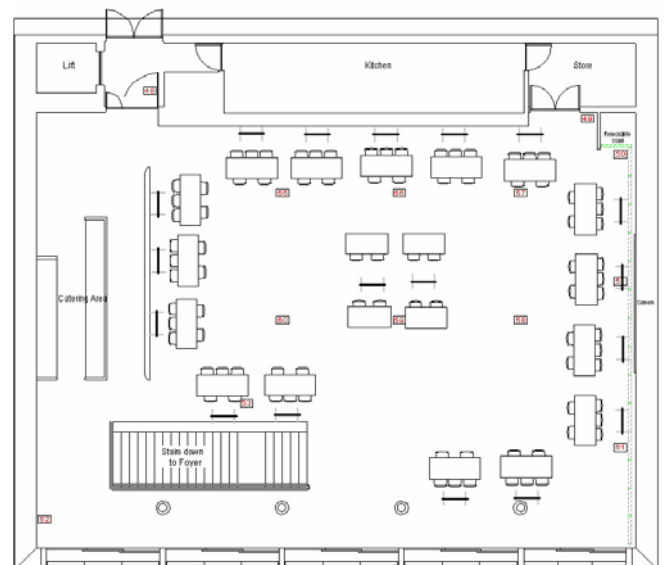
